

## CARL THOMASS 1848 FINEST JEWELLERY MADE IN GERMANY

Situated in the very heart of Munich, Marienplatz 1 has been the longstanding home to an exclusive jeweller. Carl Thomass' history of making diamond and precious stone jewellery dates back more than 170 years.

In the 19th century rich inhabitants and aristocrats acquired their jewellery from Carl Thomass, purveyor to the Court of the Bavarian kings. Today the shop attracts young couples in search of engagement rings and travellers from Europe, the US, Asia and Australia looking for one of a kind mementos to remember their special journey.

## FROM THE HEART OF MUNICH INTO THE WORLD

The yellow corner house next to the well-known townhall with its famous chimes provides an oasis of calm from the bustle of one of Germany's most visited places. Part of the precious gold jewellery is lovingly handmade in the in-house workshop. Other pieces, such as Gellner's unusual pearl and diamond designs or Leo Wittwer's famous



cross pendants, come from manufacturers in the south of Germany. Travellers from all over the world have called in at Carl Thomass to choose the rings that would end up sealing their lifelong bonds. Wedding bands from the popular German brands Christian Bauer and Max Kemper started their journey to Moscow, Shanghai and even Abuja in Nigeria right here in Munich. "That's what we're most proud of", say owners Werner and Sibylle Blessing, "Our jewellery travels from Munich all over the world!".
